

Improved Add Lines for Microsoft Project Server 2007 adds new features

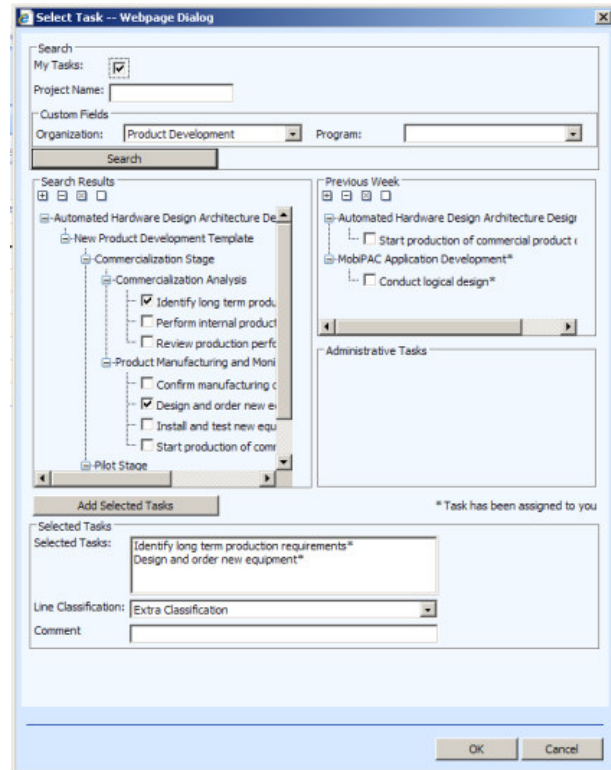

Features:

- Search and filter the task list in the Add Lines dialogue
- Copy tasks from last week's timesheet
- Prevent time reporting on "top level" and on summary task(s), both options configurable
- Prevent time reporting on tasks or assignments, where Remaining Work equals zero (0)
- Optional self assign tasks

Advantages:

The improved user interface improves the quality of time reporting. The high configurability makes it easy to adapt the processes involving timesheets to the current standards of the organization. For the first time, it is easy to prevent users from reporting time on tasks or even assignments with no remaining work. The option to prevent top level time reporting ensures that numbers from timesheets are the same as in task updates. The possibility to select from last week's tasks is a relief to many users assigned to many tasks, but working only on a few at a time.
